Fort Wayne Museum of Art Fort Wayne, Indiana

▶ \$25,000

Support for the Fort Wayne Museum of Art's new Glass Wing Project. This new permanent glass wing will showcase a selection of their expanding collection of almost 400 glass sculptures.

Arts United Center Fort Wayne, Indiana

▶ \$250,000

Support for the renovation of the Arts United Center. Updating this historic building will make its classes, job opportunities, and productions more inclusive and accessible. This was the first installment of a \$1,000,000 pledge.

Community Transportation Network Fort Wayne, Indiana

▶ \$100,000

\$50,000 in support for CTN's Drive Program that provides cars to individuals in need.
\$50,000 in support of their overarching mission to help ease the burden of transportation and support people's freedom and independence.

LC Nature Park Roanoke, Indiana

▶ \$100,000

Support for LC Nature Park to restore native habitat on 106 acres of newly acquired farmland. The project also includes grading the site, adding fencing to contain bison and elk, and creating trails for future visitors to use.

Community Cooperative Fort Myers, Florida

▶ \$5,000

Support for housing, food, and social services for those most in need after the devastation of Hurricane Ian.

J.N. "Ding" Darling National Wildlife Refuge Sanibel, Florida

▶ \$15,000

Support to help the J.N. "Ding" Darling National Wildlife Refuge rebuild after Hurricane Ian. These efforts include design and planning of new resilient buildings and planning for habitat restoration with bridges and improved water flow.
